Eligibility Rules and General Information

1. Scholarships will be awarded on an objective basis without regard to sex, age, race, religion or physical disability. Awards are made on the basis of academic achievement, educational goals, and school extracurricular and community activities, and such additional criteria as may be deemed appropriate. Some examples of such criteria include special awards, financial need or the results of performance tests.
2. Grants may be made for study at any accredited public or private post-secondary educational institution or state-licensed trade school.
3. Grant awards shall be used to pay costs of tuition, books or other required fees to an accredited public or private post-secondary educational institution or trade school.
4. Scholarships will be for the first year of study. The scholarship will be funded by the Montana Bankers Education Foundation and paid directly to the educational institution on behalf of the student. Awards are paid only after students complete and submit a **Required Student Information Form** to the Montana Community Foundation.
5. Scholarships will generally be split into two payments for fall and spring semesters; however, scholarships will be paid in full to any trade schools and other accredited public or private educational institutions that run a continuous program of study.
6. Scholarship recipients are selected and recommended by the Scholarship Advisory Committee of the bank through which they have applied.



Scholarship Criteria

Criteria that must be met and proven before a scholarship may be awarded:

- Applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better, as evidenced by most recent high school or college transcript
- Applicant must be a graduating senior of one of the following high schools:
Opheim High School; Nashua High School; Hinsdale High School;
Glasgow High School; Frazer High School; Lustre High School.
