



Sweet Grass County High School Centennial Scholarship

Criteria that must be met and proven before a scholarship may be awarded:

- Applicant must be a graduate of Sweet Grass County High School
- Applicant **must have completed** at least one year of study and be a student in good standing in an accredited 2- or 4-year program at a college, university, business or vocational school.
- Applicant must be actively pursuing a degree or certificate of completion, or may be a student who is seeking an advanced degree.

Additional criteria, which may be used by the selection committee to make their decision, include but are not limited to:

- Financial Need
- Ability to complete the proposed program
- Extra – curricular activities, including school and non-school activities
- Academic achievement
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Please note:

*The scholarship shall be limited to **three consecutive years** or the completion of the academic program in which the scholarship recipient is enrolled, whichever occurs first. Student must reapply annually.*
